- Reliable – you can come along most weeks
- Friendly – you can make people feel welcome

The role will include:

- Being available 1.30pm to 5pm on Sundays
- Helping Club Leaders set-up craft activities
- After being shown an activity by Club Leaders, helping attendees with that craft activity
- Keeping your craft table organised
- Clearing-up your craft table at the end of the sessions and helping the tidy-up the hall
- Following our equality, safeguarding and health and safety procedures
